

Studying Thai massage

Level 1 (Week 1 Monday-Thursday)

This course establishes the foundation of professional Thai massage. The concepts of meridians, energy lines (Sen), and Yin and Yang are introduced. This course covers practical aspects such as stretches, acupressure points, proper use of body weight, and techniques using thumbs, palms, elbows, and feet. Additional emphasis is placed on deep, focused abdominal (Hara) work.

At the end of the Level 1 course, students will be able to perform an effective 1½ hour treatment sequence covering the front (lying on the back) and the back part of the body.

entitle you to a refund of your holiday cost from us. Your right to a refund and/ or compensation from us is set out in these conditions. If any payments to you are due from us, any payment from the airline will be deducted from this amount. If your airline does not comply with these rules you should complain to the Air Transport Users' Council on 020 7240 6061 www.auc.org.uk.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Travel documents include (without limitation) airline tickets, hotel vouchers, tour vouchers or any other document (Whether electronic form or otherwise) used to confirm an arrangement with a service provider, Travel documents may be subject to certain conditions and/or restrictions including (Without limitation) being non-refundable, non-date-changeable and subject to cancellation and/or amendment fees, all travel documents are non-transferable, all airline tickets must be issued in the name of the passport/photo identity holder; some carriers will deny carriage if the name varies and the booking maybe cancelled. Please review your travel documentation carefully and advise us immediately of any errors in names, dates or timings, it is your responsibility to collect all travel documents prior to travel.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: It is essential that you and all members of your party have adequate travel insurance. Insurance can be purchased through your travel agent, post office, credit card company or other insurers. In general your policy should cover personal accident, death, medical and repatriation expenses, loss of valuables and baggage, cancellation or curtailment, missed departure, delay and legal expenses. Should you or any member of your party decide not to take out travel insurance we cannot accept any responsibility for any costs that arise which would otherwise have been met if insurance cover had been taken out.

PASSPORTS & VISAS: All travellers must have a valid passport for international travel and many countries require at least 6 months validity from the date of return and some countries require a machine-readable passport. It is important that you ensure that you have valid passports-visas and re-entry permits which meet the requirements of immigration and other government authorities. Any fines, penalties, payments or expenditures incurred as a result of such documents not meeting the requirements of those authorities will be your sole responsibility (except to the extent caused by fault on our part). If you need information regarding visa and other travel document requirements for your trip, please ask your travel consultant.

TRAVEL ADVICE: Mostly Massage or Surreal Holidays make no representations as to the safety, conditions or other issues that may exist at any destination. We recommend that you contact the Foreign & Commonwealth Office or visit their website at https://www.gov.uk/government/organisations/foreign-commonwealth-for general travel advice, as well as specific advice (including safety alert levels) relating to the destination you wish to visit.

HEALTH: You must ensure that you are aware of any health requirements and recommended precautions relevant to your travel and ensure that you carry all necessary vaccination documentation. In some cases, failure to present required vacation documentation (e.g. proof of Yellow Fever vaccination) may deny you entry in to a country. We recommend that you consult with your local doctor, travel medical service or specialist vaccination clinic before commencing your travel. TAXES: Certain taxes are mandatory in various countries. There may also be an additional local tax charged at some airports. All taxes are subject to change without notice. All prices and charges in this brochure include Australian GST or UK VAT where applicable.

DEPOSITS & FINAL PAYMENTS: A non-refundable deposit of £350 per person for international bookings and £30 non-refundable deposit per person for domestic bookings is payable within seven days of confirmation -refundable of your reservation. You will be notified at the time of your reservation any additional deposit requirements apply. All deposits are non-refundable for changes of mind or cancellations by you (subject to your rights under EU law (Regulation 261/2004). Full payment for your holiday/Wellness or Thai Massage, Spa & Yoga package is required at least 60 days prior to departure, or by the set end date or payment deadline specified in individual package conditions, whichever is earliest. If you do not pay us the deposit or your balance by the due date, we reserve the right to treat your booking as cancelled and to apply the appropriate cancellation charges. A deposit holds services requested but does not guarantee prices. Bookings made within 60 days of departure will only be accepted if full payment is received by Mostly Massage or Surreal Holidays at the time of reservation. The price of your holiday may change at any time until the full payment is received and airline tickets are issued. Tickets will be issued within one business day of receiving full payment. If we have to change any part of your booking for reasons beyond our control, For example if an airline changes its schedules, a hotelier over books a hotel accommodation or if there are any changes in applicable taxes or charges, we will notify you any such changes result in your holiday costing more or otherwise being materially different from that originally booked, then you may cancel the holiday and we will refund any monies already paid less any charges levied by suppliers.

YOUR FINANCIAL PROTECTION: We hold an Air Travel Organiser's Licence issued by the Civil Aviation Authority (ATOL number 7299). The Package Travel,

Package Holidays and Package Tours Regulations 1992 require us to provide security for the monies that you pay for the package holidays booked with us. We provide this security by way of an ATOL (number 7299) administered by the Civil Aviation Authority. When you buy an ATOL protected air inclusive holiday package you will receive a Confirmation Invoice from us, or via your travel agent, confirming your arrangements and your protection under our Air Travel Organiser's Licence. For further information visit the ATOL website at: www.atol.org.uk. In the unlikely event of our insolvency, the CAA will ensure that you are not stranded abroad and will arrange to refund any money you have paid us for an advance booking.

CANCELLATION BY US: We reserve the right in any circumstances to cancel your holiday and in such an event we shall seek to offer a suitable alternative or a full refund of monies paid to us. Except for events beyond our control (see Important Note above) or if you default on payment we will not cancel any booking within 70 days of the scheduled departure date.

CANCELLATION BY YOU: Should you or any member of your party wish to cancel your booking at any time please notify us immediately. If we have already issued a Confirmation of Booking it is essential that you indicate your intention to cancel in writing to either your travel agent or ourselves. This instruction to cancel must be signed by the person who made the original booking. We will not effect the cancellation until such written advice is received. The following fees apply if we change or cancel a booking at your request. International: after full payment, the cancellation fee on packages will be £350 per person plus any Supplier fees on the land portion of your booking and any airline cancellation fees on the air portion. Domestic: after full payment, the cancellation fee on packages will be £30 per person plus any supplier fees on the land portion of your booking. Domestic airfares are non-refundable.

ALTERATIONS BY YOU: If you wish to change your holiday in anyway after we have confirmed your booking, we will do our best to meet your revised requirements. We do, however, reserve the right to charge an amendment fee of £50 per booking, plus any appropriate additional holiday cost. Any requests received within 70 days of departure may be treated as a cancellation and rebooking and thus subject to the cancellation charges shown below.

ALTERATIONS BY US: Your holiday arrangements may have been made many months in advance and changes can, therefore, occur for a variety of reasons. Many of these changes are very minor in nature and should not affect the overall enjoyment of your holiday. Where they are more significant we will do our best to advise you or your travel agent prior to your departure. In accordance with EU Regulation 2111/2005 we are required to advise you of the actual carrier operating your flight/connecting flight/transfer. We do this by listing the carriers to be used, or likely to be used, on our Confirmation Invoice. Any changes to the actual airline after you have received your tickets will be notified to you as soon as possible and in all cases at check-in or at the boarding gate. Such a change is deemed to be a minor change. Sometimes a major alteration has to be made before your departure. We will give you the options of either a) accepting the revised arrangements, b) transferring to such other holidays as we may have available at its advertised price, or c) cancelling your holiday with a full refund of all monies paid. Compensation will be payable on the scale shown below in accordance with the option you decide to take, unless the change arises as a result of events beyond our control (see Important Note below) . A major change is considered to be: a significant change of resort, a change of accommodation to that of a lower category and or price; change of airport other than Heathrow or Gatwick that causes great inconvenience; change of your departure or return by more than 12 hours

SUPPLIER CHANGE AND CANCELLATION FEES: Cancelled bookings may also incur supplier fees, which can be up to 100% of the cost of the booking, regardless of whether travel has commenced. Supplier fees may also apply where a booking is changed and when tickets or documents are re-issued, where we incur any liability for a supplier cancellation fee for any booking which you change or cancel, you agree to indemnify us for the amount of that fee. REFUNDS: Subject to your refund and remedy rights under the EU Consumer Law, no refund is available for cancellations after the holiday package has commenced or in respect of any tours, accommodation, meals or any other services not utilized. Selected holiday packages consist of a combined airfare and land tour component which cannot be sold and subsequently cancelled and/or refunded separately. Requests for refunds received more than six months after the departure date for travel will not be accepted.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE OF HOLIDAY: All passengers are responsible for the cost of their own travel arrangements to and from their departure point (as set out in the brochure). The cost of anything not specifically noted as being included in the holiday package is at the passenger's expense.

Any facilities shown as included are subject to change at anytime. In particular; you agree that in certain circumstances (such as where you request us to arrange International travel for you), we are permitted to disclose your personal information overseas recipients. Such recipients may include the overseas travel service provider(s) (e.g. Accommodation or our providers) with whom you seek to make a booking. These travel service providers will in most cases receive your personal information in the country in which they will provide the services to you or in which their business is based. We may also disclose your personal information to our overseas related entities (including those in New Zealand, Thailand and the UK and to service providers who perform services for us outside of Australia. GOVERNING LAW: If any dispute arises between you and us, the laws of Australia will apply if you are travelling from Australia. If a dispute arises between you and Surreal Holidays as a traveller from the UK then the laws of the United Kingdom will apply. You irrevocably and unconditionally submit to the jurisdiction of the courts of Australia if you are a traveller originating from Australia and irrevocably and unconditionally submit to the jurisdiction of the courts of the United Kingdom if you are a traveller originating from the UK, and waive any right that you may have to object to an action being brought in those courts.


